

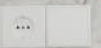

<p>Minimalistic Design: Boast a sleek, minimalistic design that enhances the bathroom's aesthetic without visible tracks or bulky hardware.</p>	<p>Visible Components: Often include visible rollers and tracks, which can detract from a streamlined bathroom design.</p>
